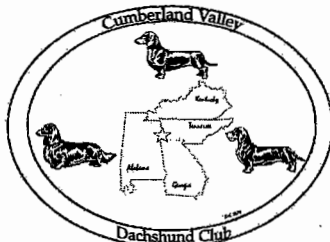

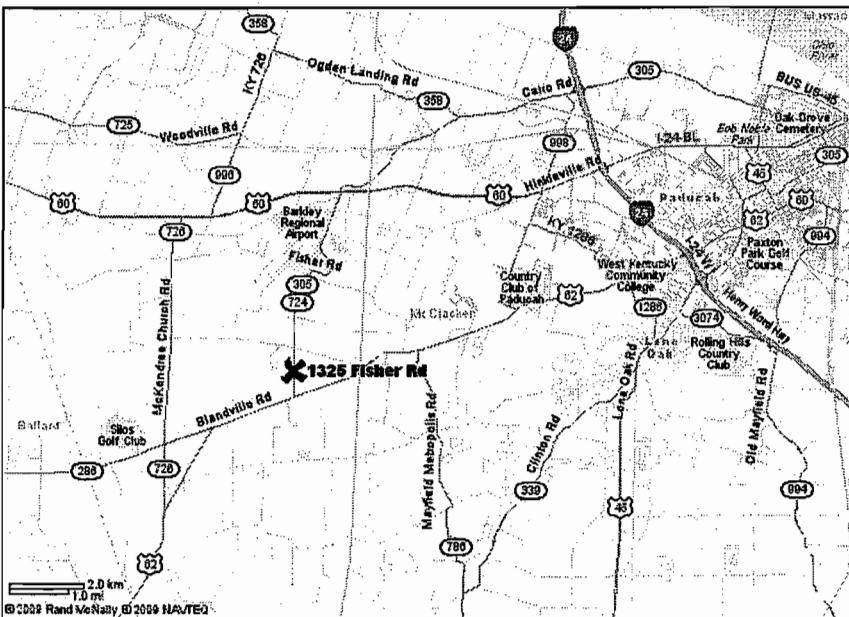
These shows enforce the policy that if there is damage to Motel property, disciplinary action will be taken. This action could result in AKC privileges being suspended. When not crated, dogs are to be on leash. When dogs are exercised outdoors, dogs must be cleaned-up after. Exhibitors are requested and expected to be responsible for their animals, and their own personal behavior.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

The Paducah Kennel Club Show Site and Club Building is located West of I-24.

From North bound and South bound I-24

Take exit 7 off I-24. Go West on US Highway 62 to Fisher Road. Turn North (right at Fisher Road – Kentucky Highway 305). The Show Site is approximately ¼ mile from US Highway 62 and approximately 6 miles from I-24.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to RV's, and Exhibitors at noon Friday, April 2, 2010. Dogs must be removed from the Show Site following Best of Breed judging on Sunday, April 4, 2010.

**Paducah Kennel Club will have lunches available for sale Saturday and Sunday.
Free Coffee and Doughnuts Saturday and Sunday mornings provided by CVDC.**

- No smoking is allowed inside the building. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on Show Grounds.
- Exhibitor parking will be designated. There will be a designated area outside the building for loading and unloading of dogs and equipment.
- Bring lawn chairs for seating.
- RV sites are not level. Water will not be available for filling RV holding tanks.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed, Variety, or Class judging.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.
- All Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed.
- Be advised, an Event Committee hearing will be convened to consider charges and discipline to individuals failing to observe event guidelines, and/or verbally abusing show personnel. Failure to observe event guidelines could result in loss of AKC privileges.
- The Show Giving Club and the Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee and Event Service Fee are collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording and the Event Service Fees are collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These AKC fees are included in the Entry Fees stated in this premium.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If by conditions beyond the control of the Show giving Club it is necessary to cancel or stop the Show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made. Due to expense of processing, refunds of \$4.00 or less will not be made.

Telephone, fax, or email entries cannot be accepted at the Show Secretary's address. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and/or photocopies without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Entry Forms must be signed. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
